DRESS REHEARSAL ATTENDANCE

If a student will miss dress rehearsal, notify Melissa Morey (mmorey@mnyouthsymphonies.org) as soon as possible. MYS staff and the conductor will discuss whether continuing the trimester is in the best interest of the student and their ensemble. (Final decision made by MYS.)

CONCERT ATTENDANCE

All students sit with their orchestra during the concert. Students are expected to support their fellow musicians in other orchestras by staying for the duration of the concert. If a student needs to leave early, notify Melissa Morey in advance to make arrangements. Students <u>should</u> <u>not leave early</u> without prior permission.

CONCERT DRESS GUIDELINES

The purpose for the following dress code is so the audience will stay focused on the music during the performance and will not be distracted by individuals in the ensemble.

Concert Black attire and shoe options:

- Option 1: Black dress shirt/jacket with at least ¾ sleeves, black dress pants (no leggings) or skirt/dress with at least ¾ length, black socks, black dress shoes.
- Option 2: Black suit coat (tuxedo jacket or other), black necktie (not bowtie), black dress shirt, black socks, and black dress shoes.


